HOMEWORK	Homework is assigned regularly and is due once a week, generally Mondays.
BOARDWORK	You'll spend part of class working problems at the board and explaining your solutions.
QUIZZES	There will be very brief weekly quizzes covering the homework material. Generally these quizzes will be on Mondays. No make up quizzes are given. However, 2 of the quizzes will be dropped when determining your course grade to allow for the possibility of absences.
EXAMS	There will be 2 exams; namely a midterm and a final. Make-up exams are usually not given. The tentative date of the midterm exam is Wednesday, February 23. The final exam is scheduled by the university. Consult the final exam schedule on MyIIT for date and time.
GRADE	The course grade is determined as follows: 25% for the midterm exam, 25% for the final exam, 25% for the quizzes, 10% for boardwork and class participation, and 15% for homework.
